

RECOMMENDATIONS TO PARENTS

Parents are an integral part of the school and the school expects them to co-operate in enforcing all the guidelines that will benefit the child and assist in the smooth functioning of the school.

The school diary serves as a bridge between teachers, students and parents. Parents are requested to go through the school diary and respond to all comments made by the teachers and make sure that the Home Work assignment for the next day is done regularly.

The school insists on strict punctuality, regular school attendance, regulation regarding uniform, cleanliness in dress, good grooming and fidelity to study and work assignments.

As the medium of instruction in the school is English, parents should provide ample opportunities to their children to converse in English at Home.

See that your child carries books/ exercise books according to the time table for that day. No extra books are allowed.

Due to illness or else, If special care is required for your child, please do not hesitate to inform us. If the child is viral-infected, please do not send the child to the school to avoid infections.

No late entry will be allowed. In special case it is permitted, if prior note is issued to the principal or class teacher in writing by parents. For absence leave, please inform in writing on prescribed form available in the school diary.

No students will be allowed to leave the school campus before schedule time. In emergency, if you desire your child at home in the middle of school timings, you must bring the written note. The authority will call you to make sure that the child is handed over to proper person to avoid incidents like kidnapping.

Parents are requested not to contact their children during school timings. In case of emergency, they may contact receptionist to meet the principal and get permission to do so.

In case the child forgets any book or tiffin at home, parents can pass such things to the receptions. Student's belonging will be passed to him/ her safely. But do not make it a regular practice.

No mobile phone is allowed with students. Use of mobile by Parents/ Visitors is strictly prohibited in the school building. For any communication you can always use the school ground. We will try our best to take care of your children but in case of accident we are helpless. We will make sure that the child gets prompt and necessary treatment and the parents would be informed for the same.

The child is solely responsible to protect his/her belonging. Your child should be instructed to be careful about his/ her things. Lost property will be remained in the lost property box for working seven days. After that it will be disposed.

Children's are not allowed to bring expensive articles like transistors, calculators, mobile phones etc. to school. Children should not bring crackers, colours, to the school which will lead to expulsion of a student from the school.

Encourage your child to take balanced interest in studies, co -curricular activities and sports.

The school reserves the right to suspend or to take disciplinary action against a child whose progress in studies is constantly unsatisfactory or whose conduct is harmful to other students.

Giving presents or gifts to staff or other, demonstration of gratitude or goodwill in their honor is not allowed except with the prior permission of principal.

Parents are expected to co-operate with the school authorities in enforcing regularity and discipline. They should take an active and helpful interest in the activities of the school. If the management require s your service, you can provide your honorary service for cultural activities etc.

When you happened to visit the school, please maintain the decorum of the school and do not wear sleeveless, deep necked and short dresses. In case, the parents will be requested to leave the premises.

While communicating with school staff, please talk in soft tone. No complains will be unheard.

RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR PUPILS

Every student is expected to carry the School Diary to school every day.

Students who commute to school by their own conveyance must be in school by 07:30/ 08:25 AM, school gates will close at 07:40/ 08:30 AM. Students who report late to school for a second time in a given month will be sent back home.

Students who forget belongings can collect them from the Lost & Found in the office within 7 working days. Thereafter school is not responsible for the same.

Attendance during Republic Day and Independence Day celebrations is mandatory for all students. No leave will be sanctioned on these days.

DISCIPLINE CODE

- Any damage done to school property/ premises will enforce punitive measures of imposing fine.
- Students are accountable to the school authorities for their behavior both inside and outside the school, particularly when in the school uniform.
- Students must keep the school and classrooms clean.
- Students are not allowed to drive to the school.
- The following acts and Conduct on the part of the students will amount to misconduct.
- Misbehavior towards teachers or any other employee of the school.
- Intentional disturbance of classes.
- Absence from classes without permission of the Teacher/ Principal.
- Bullying/ Intimidating others.
- Eve-Teasing/ misbehavior towards girls- Students.
- Damaging/ disfiguring school property.
- Propagating a strike/ disruption of class.
- Association with banned organizations.
- Propagating communal/ caste feeling among students.
- > Indulging in physical violence in any manner.
- Disobeying lawful orders of the teachers/ Principal
- Bringing unauthorized people/ articles/ Instruments.
- > Theft/ Pilferage of school/ Students property
- Indulging in acts of moral turpitude.
- ➤ When students move along the corridors and when changing class, they must maintain silence and walk in a single line keeping left.
- > Students are expected to speak only in English during school hours.
- In case of misconduct, school shall take actions as per observation, which may involve.
 - · Oral warning to the student.
 - Written warnings
 - Suspension of one day from classes/ school/ period after five written warnings.
 - Final written warning in case of no improvement
 - Suspension of one week.

TRANSPORT RULES

- > Students who avail the school transport subject to the availability of seats.
- Bus facility is available on fixed routes with designated stops.
- ➤ Parents are expected to be at the stop 10 minutes before the scheduled arrival of the bus.
- ➤ Students are permitted to use only their designated bus and bus stop. No change will be allowed without written permission of the authorized person.
- ➤ Bus will leave the stop at the designated time, In case a child misses a bus, parents are requested to drop the child to the school.
- ➤ Fixed seats will be allotted to the students in the bus. Students are expected to remain seated while the bus is in motion. Students are expected to maintain silence and behave in a decorous manner at all times.
- ➤ Any case of negligence by the bus driver or attendant should be brought to the notice of the transport incharge.
- ➤ Parents are requested not to make any oral request to the bus driver or attendant. Any request should be made in writing to the transport in charge.
- ➤ Though utmost care is taken while transporting the children, the school will not be held responsible for any untoward incident.
- A child who consistently reports late at the bus stop or caught misbehaving more than 3 times in the bus, will be refrained from using the bus service.
- ➤ In case of an emergency and the child has to leave school before school hours the procedure to be followed is:
 - Written request by the parents.
 - Permission slip obtained from the office and signed by the authorities to be shown at the gate.
 - School leaving register to be signed by the parents.


